Dear Future Graduate and families of the Class of 2018,

As we approach graduation, I want to congratulate our Class of 2018 on reaching this important milestone. It has been an honor and privilege to work with you over these past few years.

Sehome's graduation ceremony will be held on **Saturday, June 9 at 5:00 p.m. in Western Washington University's Carver Gymnasium**. Please refer to this letter and the enclosed End of Year Schedule of Events for dates, times, and places of events pertaining to senior specific activities.

It is mandatory, no exceptions, that all students, including Running Start students, attend and participate in the graduation rehearsal on **Thursday, June 7 from 9:30 – 11:30 a.m. in the Sehome High School Cafeteria**. Please plan accordingly and make arrangements to attend the rehearsal.

Admission to graduation ceremony is by ticket only. No exceptions. Each senior will receive 10 tickets. Lost tickets cannot be replaced. Tickets **must be** presented at the door upon arrival. Guests without tickets will not gain entrance into the building. Tickets are required, regardless of age.

Parking is available for all ticket holders in the 12A and C lots on WWU's campus; see enclosed map. Guests who require accommodated/limited mobility seating may complete a reservation request in the main office at Sehome High School. Reserved seating requests are due no later than **May 18, 2018. Requests submitted after May 18 will not be accepted.**

Accommodated/limited mobility parking will be available in lot 17G. Guests wishing to utilize lot 17G must present their accommodated/limited mobility ticket to gain access to the lot.

Graduation is a time-honored tradition where family, friends, and stakeholders in your life gather together to celebrate this special day, honoring thirteen years of hard-work, personal growth, and determination. To uphold the values and traditions of our graduation celebration, we ask seniors to present themselves in a mature, respectful, and professional manner. Therefore, we ask our students to wear proper attire from head to toe. Caps and gowns are not permitted to be altered or

decorated. WWU does not permit balloons, noise-makers, streamers, signs larger than 2 x 2 in the gymnasium, or selfies on the stage.

After the ceremony, we ask that families meet their student in Red Square (Campus Fountain), please refer to the enclosed map. Seniors will pick up their diploma directly after the ceremony and meet parents in Red Square.
