GPA 3.0 or above, US citizen or permanent legal resident, planning to attend 4 year college or university the fall after graduation. Scholarships awarded to athletes expressing how sports have helped them grow into strong leaders at school and in their communities. Twenty scholarships will be awarded.

Procedures: Application is on-line. Candidates should exemplify good moral character, sportsmanship, commitment to community, leadership, academic excellence, diversity in sports. 20 \$20,000 (\$5,000 for 4 yrs) scholarships will be awarded.

Eligibility: SENIOR, US citizen or legal resident. The more applicants the more chances of winning! Plan of full time enrollment in a 2 or 4-year college/university in the fall after graduation.

Procedures: Must be ambitious and motivated, as evidenced by outstanding achievement in school, community, or work activities, and be recommended by an unrelated adult who can attest to the student's achievement. Applicants will describe an outstanding long-term achievement they have accomplished in a non-academic activity or project. Only 10,000 applications will be accepted.

In addition to listing of activities, awards, etc., applicants are asked to describe in detail an outstanding achievement they have accomplished in a non-academic activity or project. See application for details. For every student who wins a scholarship a \$1,000 grant will be awarded to their high school.
