

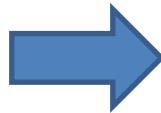
# Sehome High School Recommended Pathway:

- **Total Required Credits: 3.0**

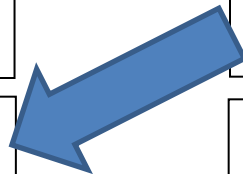
**Freshman Year:** Traditionally, students have taken “0.5 Social Studies Elective” credit in 9<sup>th</sup> grade. Course options include...

- Psychology (Year Long)
- Sociology
- World Geography
- AP Human Geography (Year Long)
- History of Sports in America
- WWII through Film & Lit
- Criminology
- Ethnic Studies



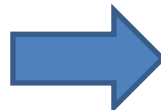
**Sophomore Year:** Traditionally, students take “1.0 Current World History” credit in 10<sup>th</sup> grade. Course options include...

- Contemporary World History
- Advanced Placement World History



**Junior Year:** Traditionally, students take “1.0 United States History” credit in 11<sup>th</sup> grade. Course options include...

- United States History
- Advanced Placement United States History



**Senior Year:** Traditionally, students take “0.5 Civics” credit in 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Course options include...

- Civics
- Political Science: AP U.S. and Comparative (international) Government
